## Planned Assistance Level for SY 2011-2012

The USDA has announced that the national average meal rate for 2011-2012 will be .2225 cents per meal. This is an increase of .02 cents from 2010-2011. You will see the change in your PAL amount when accessing the FNP system to complete the November monthly survey.
