

North Dakota Charter School Profile

The State of North Dakota has not enacted statute to permit the operation of Charter Schools, as defined by federal law. The State has reported to the U.S. Department of Education that there are no currently operating charter schools within the State. In the place of federally defined charter schools, the State has enacted a policy of open enrollment, which allows parents to openly enroll their children within adjoining schools and school districts.
