**North Dakota School Violence and Drug Statistics**

**1807** – Total number of violent and drug-related incidents in North Dakota schools that resulted in suspension or expulsion:

- 800 reported fighting/mutual altercation incidents;
- 310 reported tobacco incidents;
- 119 reported simple assault incidents;
- 177 reported drug incidents;
- 82 reported alcohol incidents;
- 89 reported terrorizing incidents;
- 38 reported knife (blade 2.5” or greater) incidents;
- 53 reported assault incidents;
- 19 reported other object incidents;
- 29 reported reckless endangerment incidents
- 30 reported hazing incidents;
- 31 reported robbery incidents;
- 11 reported other offenses resulting in 10 days out of school suspension or expulsion;
- 0 reported handgun incidents;
- 1 reported serious bodily injury incidents;
- 12 reported sexual imposition incidents;
- 1 reported rifle/shotgun incidents;
- 3 reported other firearm incident;
- 1 reported aggravated assault incident;
- 1 reported murder, manslaughter, negligent homicide, kidnapping, felonious restraint, inciting a riot, or gross sexual imposition/rape incidents
