**Quick Stats
School Violence and Drug Statistics**

1782 – Total number of violent and drug-related incidents in North Dakota schools that resulted in suspension or expulsion:

- 813 reported fighting/mutual altercation incidents;
- 294 reported tobacco incidents;
- 147 reported simple assault incidents;
- 145 reported drug incidents;
- 122 reported alcohol incidents;
- 98 reported terrorizing incidents;
- 36 reported knife (blade 2.5” or greater) incidents;
- 27 reported assault incidents;
- 20 reported other object incidents;
- 18 reported other offenses resulting in 10 days out of school suspension or expulsion;
- 17 reported hazing incidents;
- 16 reported reckless endangerment incidents
- 13 reported robbery incidents;
- 4 reported handgun incidents;
- 4 reported serious bodily injury incidents;
- 4 reported sexual imposition incidents;
- 2 reported other firearm incident;
- 1 reported rifle/shotgun incidents;
- 1 reported aggravated assault incident;
- 0 reported murder, manslaughter, negligent homicide, kidnapping, felonious restraint, inciting a riot, or gross sexual imposition/rape incidents

Total Public/Nonpublic K-12 enrollment 2006-2007: 103,706

Truancy Incidents reported in 2006-2007:

- 12,933 days ND students were truant
