North Dakota Vision Services/School for the Blind (NDVS/SB) functions as a statewide comprehensive resource working cooperatively with related agencies in providing a full range of services to all persons who are blind or visually impaired, including those with additional disabilities. Services include evaluation, consultation, and instruction in the expanded core curriculum areas (i.e., orientation and mobility, Braille, Braille music, daily living skills, assistive technology, career education, recreation/leisure, social interaction, self-determination, and visual efficiency skills). Short-term programs include specific skills, compensatory skills, summer camps, and adult weeks. In-service training is provided to teachers, paraprofessionals, and parents at NDSB and in the home, school, or job site.

Services provided via the Vision Resource Center include adaptive materials for the visually impaired, Talking Book Machine Lending Agency, The Store, Braille productions, large prints, print disables and Braille textbook repository, descriptive videos, professional and consumer library, access to information, and toll-free number.

The North Dakota School for the Deaf is a fully accredited educational institution serving the educational needs of hearing impaired students ages 0 to 21 in North Dakota. Children, birth to 3 years of age, are served through the Parent/Infant program and children, ages 3 to 21 years, are served through the school program. Ages 21 and beyond (deaf and later-deafened adults) may access services through outreach programs.

In addition to the school's traditional role as an educational institution, NDSD also has become a resource center on deafness, serving the needs of hearing impaired citizens statewide. Through its Outreach Program and Dual Sensory Project, the school has expanded consultation services, evaluation and assessment services, and off-campus educational services, and the needs of adults with hearing loss. Through collaborative and cooperative ventures with other agencies, the school has improved the delivery of services to citizens with hearing loss.
