**1. State Aid Formula Statistics**

ADM is the average daily membership for state aid purposes.

Weighted ADM is the additional weighted units included in the state aid formula for special populations, summer programs and isolated schools.

School Size Factor is the school district size factor applied based on school size. The factors ranges between 1.25 and 1.00.

Weighted Student Units is determined by multiplying the school district size factor times the weighted student units.

Equity Percent is the district's imputed taxable valuation per student divided by the state average imputed taxable valuation per student. Districts below 90% of the state average receive an equity payment. Districts above 150% have their state aid payment reduced. Districts between 90% and 150% of the state average are not adjusted.

**2. Other District Statistics**

Rural Students Transported is the estimated number of rural students transported in the district.

Average Route Miles is the average bus route in miles.

Open Enrolled In is the number of students attending the district under open enrollment.

Open Enrolled Out is the number of resident students attending another district under open enrollment.

ADA percent is the average daily attendance rate for the school district. This number is taken from school district financial reports.
