

Directions and Explanation of Survey Results

North Dakota accepted the American Recovery Reinvestment Act and State Fiscal Stabilization Funds as part of the Obama Administration stimulus program. The funding was accepted by the Governor, and subsequently the Department of Public Instruction was authorized by the State Legislature to distribute these funds to public school districts. North Dakota had to provide several assurances as a condition of acceptance and distribution of the federal dollars. Among the assurances is the requirement that all North Dakota public schools must publicly report their current practices in the teacher and leader evaluation system used in their district. In order to meet this and other requirements the Department organized a State Education Planning Committee comprised of statewide constituency groups.

Several areas are required to be included in this report; therefore, a survey was developed to ensure all federal reporting criteria are met. This survey was developed by a sub-committee of the state planning committee of education leaders, including Lois Myran, DPI; Doug Johnson, NDCEL; Janet Welk, ESPB; Bev Nielson, NDSBA; and Dakota Draper, NDEA.
