Ten Titles Under the NCLB Act

■ **Title I** – Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged

• Title I Part A

Title I provides financial assistance to state and local educational agencies to meet the needs of educationally deprived, at risk children.

• Title I Part B Subpart 1 – Reading First

This grant program is designed to select, implement, and provide professional development for teachers using scientifically-based reading programs; to implement effective methods and instructional strategies in the classroom based on scientifically-based reading research; and to ensure accountability through ongoing, valid and reliable screening, diagnostic, and classroom-based instructional assessments.

• Title I Part B Subpart 3 – Even Start Family Literacy Program

Even Start is a federally funded family literacy program that integrates early childhood education, adult literacy education, parenting education, and Parent and Child Together Time (PACT).

• Title I Part C – Migrant Education

The Migrant program has provided schools with high quality education to migrant families and support services intended to improve deprivation caused by frequent mobility and poverty.

• Title I Part D – Neglected and Delinquent

The purpose of this subpart is to provide funding to support educational assistance, transition activities, and at-risk drop-out prevention programs to neglected, delinquent, and at-risk children.
