**Any Town Public School District Policy:**

The Any Town Public School District uses enrollment to determine line item budget amounts for each building. Once these foundation aid dollars are established per school, the Title I dollars are then used to supplement or add to the amount available for materials and supplies at each building.

The chart above demonstrates the distribution of the foundation aid monies per school's curriculum materials and instructional supplies line item accounts.

The consolidated application dollars are in addition to these per base dollars budgeted per school.
